

The following Terms and Conditions apply to the Achievement Program (AP) “Education Member Competition”, 2019.

Conditions of entry

Information on how to enter and details of prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in ‘Education member competition’ constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Only entries that are submitted and comply with these Terms and Conditions may take part in this Competition.

- 1) The Promoter is the *Achievement Program*, 615 St Kilda Rd, Melbourne Victoria 3004. The Achievement Program (AP) is supported by the Victorian Government and delivered by Cancer Council Victoria (CCV).
- 2) The competition promotion period commences August 26th, 2019, 00:00:01am AEST and closes October 18th, 2019, 11:59:59pm AEST.
- 3) All Victorian early childhood services, primary schools and secondary schools who are active members of the AP during the promotional period will be eligible to enter this competition. For the purposes of this competition, to be an ‘active member’ a school or service must have logged on to the new AP portal after its launch in October 2018.
- 4) To enter:
 - a. Persons must be staff, families and students or other representatives of a school or early childhood service that is an active member of the AP. There can only be one entry per school/service.

- 5) Incomplete, indecipherable or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid. The judges' and Promoter's decision in relation to any aspect of the competition is final and binding on each person who enters. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 6) The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably suspects that such materials are prohibited by these Terms and Conditions, any relevant law, or otherwise deemed inappropriate. This is at the Promoter's absolute discretion and discussions will not be entered into. Entries that are considered unlawful, harassing, defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, obscene, profane, sexually orientated, racially offensive, contain objectionable content or are otherwise inappropriate will not be deemed valid and will be rejected.

- 7) By entering the Competition, entrants consent to receipt of any email regarding the competition, and other emails which inform the entrant of the Promoter's other publications, products, services and events and promote relevant third-party goods and services.
- 8) By entering the Competition, the school/ service provides the AP with permission to reproduce and use the competition answer and school/service name for purposes associated with promoting the Achievement Program.
- 9) This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners. Each entry will be individually judged based on the merit of the information provided. Judging will take place in the week commencing October 21st, 2019 an Achievement Program panel of judges. There will be 10 winners, 5 early childhood services and 5 schools. The 10 prize winners prize will be notified by phonecall and email by Friday October 25th, 2019, 5:00pm AEST.
- 10) Winners will be promoted on the AP blog by Friday October 25th, 2019, 5:00pm AEST.

- 12) The AP will keep records of this competition for 3 years.
